#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- 1. <u>Capital Campaign</u>: Launch of campaign week of May 12, and Sunday May 18<sup>th</sup> coffee hour. Fr. Tom will check to see if Betsy McCandless for June availability, after coffee hour, concerning how to include St. Peter's in your estate planning.
- 2. <u>Signage</u>: We do have a company lined up. Bob and Fr. Tom need to meet on this. The electronic sign is doing a great job.
- 3. <u>Tree care on church property</u>: Trees all done! They did more than we planned on, and they reduced price due to folks taking the wood. Original quote was \$9,900; and the final bill was \$7,400.05.
- 4. <u>Safe Church Training for Vestry Members</u>: 7 vestry members attended. Kathleen will send out emails on completion for folks particularly around the Maine licensing. Kathleen will also get a phone/email list for notification should we need to do it.
- 5. <u>Planning and Implementing Parish Safe Church Policy</u>: Anne & Fr. Tom met and looked at the model policy for the church. Emily Keniston is looking further into this.
- 6. <u>Masonry:</u> In February vestry approved a contract with Haskell & Hall. Contract signed and we will see them for spring of 2026. (will remove from list until spring of 2026)
- 7. <u>Commission on Ministry</u>: Myrna Koonce will be ordained to transitional diaconate on Sunday, April 27<sup>th</sup> at 4 pm. Fr Tom has been invited to preach.
- 8. Outside Cameras: Bob, Wayne & Chris will speak about it.
- 9. Updated Directory: It has been distributed at coffee hour. We can send it out with Constant Contact.
- 10. <u>Elevator Buzzer & Phone</u>: Chris Hickey is replacing the cable to make the phone work. It is a more expensive proposition to fix the buzzer. We will keep investigating, a wireless doorbell may work.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Scholarship Fund: There were some funds incorporated into general investments. Anita was chair of a committee. It was established in Mr. Hilton's memory for parishioners and community members. In the past, one from each was awarded. There has been a budget item for \$200 but it has not been awarded. There was \$1800 put into the Fidelity fund. We will have a committee, a policy for awarding it. Anita will work on it, Bob, Lorna and Kathleen will help. Motion made to approve the request for funds, executive committee suggested \$200. It was approved.

<u>The Little Library</u>: Has been destroyed once again. Chris suggested maybe move it to the Alton St side. We will try again.

Motion: Bob Simmons moved to move \$20,000 from Rector's Fidelity Fund. Authorized by the vestry.

### **REPORTS**

1. <u>Junior Warden</u> (Wayne Franklin): LED lights were installed. Solar electricity applications submitted for two buildings. The sink in the kitchen is useable, thanks to Bob Simmons & Mark. Elevator update – repairs done and signs installed after malfunction, about \$600 costs. Chris Hickey has been working on telephone communication for church bldg. The masonry contract was signed, work will begin in Spring of '26. The tree work was done; wood is free and for the taking, the lawn will require some extra

- attention. Tenants leaving April 30<sup>th</sup>; property will be checked & repairs made, new tenants hopefully for June 1. Sacristy work was mentioned in Altar Guild. Bob Simmons said the bell will be going to Bishopswood.
- 2. <u>Senior Warden</u> (Anita Chandler): We are in a great place; every Sunday there are new people every week. Our growth is both young and old. It is an exciting time to be at St. Peter's.
- 3. Rector's Report (Fr. Tom Mousin): Several new people we may see again. Coffee hour is inviting, and people are helpful in getting new people downstairs. Do take note if someone is missing and decide if you need to reach out; Fr. Tom's experience is that people are grateful for being remembered when they are unable to be there. Being-With is a great program, excited to see people attending and that it is lay led! There are plans afoot for more gardening with Creation Care in the spring.
